

BUILD A SKI-THEMED MUTI-ROUND COMPETITION

Multi-round competitions are perfect for December because they let you keep things moving across shifting schedules.



Competition Concept: "The Winter Slalom"

A skiing-inspired competition where each round represents a "slope" or "run."

Round Examples:

- Round 1 The Bunny Slope: Follow-ups
- Round 2 The Blue Run: Meetings booked
- Round 3 The Red Run: Opportunities created
- Round 4 The Black Diamond: Deals won or closed-lost reviews

You can weight metrics differently based on difficulty – just like a real mountain.

Why it works

- Visually fun and super easy to theme
- Feels like a journey (perfect for streaks + momentum)
- Breaks December into achievable micro-goals
- Works for mixed schedules because each round resets focus.



Bonus Element

Add a **Ski Lodge Reward** for the first person that reaches the summit, something simple like:

- Late start Monday
- Team hot chocolate/coffee
- Lunch on the company



Lottery Competition HOLIDAY PARTY

Lotteries are one of your most powerful low-stress competition formats, especially when you combine them with **manual KPI input because** it doesn't rely on volume of activity.

Competition Concept: "The Holiday Door Prize Draw"

Instead of basing entries on deals or revenue, use manual reporting so any behavior can earn tickets.

Examples of manual input behaviors:

- Logging referrals
- Contributing to pipeline cleanup
- Adding customer stories
- Submitting CSAT or NPS responses

- Helping another teammate
- Contributing office holiday snacks
- Wearing an ugly sweater
- Participating in the office charity drive

Every manual submission = a ticket.

At your holiday party (or virtual gathering), spin the wheel to see who wins!

Prize Ideas:

- A free "late start" day
- \$25 coffee card
- Spa card
- Company swag (even better, let them choose!)
- A silly gag gift
- A "leave early Friday" coupon
- One competition pick next year (this can get surprisingly creative!)

This bridges fun + productivity without adding pressure during the slow season.





Missions are perfect for small daily surprises that can be achieved through activities not tracked in SalesScreen.

Concept: "Secret Sales Santa" Mission Series

Instead of a physical gift exchange, each day reps receive a mission encouraging them to spread a bit of holiday cheer.

Mission Examples:

- "Give anonymous praise via an endorsement today."
 - This one can be tricky, but a good workaround is to recruit another teammate to post the endorsement on your anonymous behalf - this gets even more people in on the game!
 - Give endorsements to as many people as you can to create confusion on who you could have for secret santa.
- "Share a helpful resource in the team channel."
- "Celebrate a peer's metric by posting a holiday GIF."
- "Bring a teammate a cup of coffee/tea"

Optional Add-On

Reveal Secret Santas at the end of the week and make sure to highlight:

- Most endorsements given
- Most Missions completed

Best act of support

This strengthens culture even when people are working odd hours or in different regions and time zones!

You can even run a small challenge: "Find the Most Festive Celebration Video."
